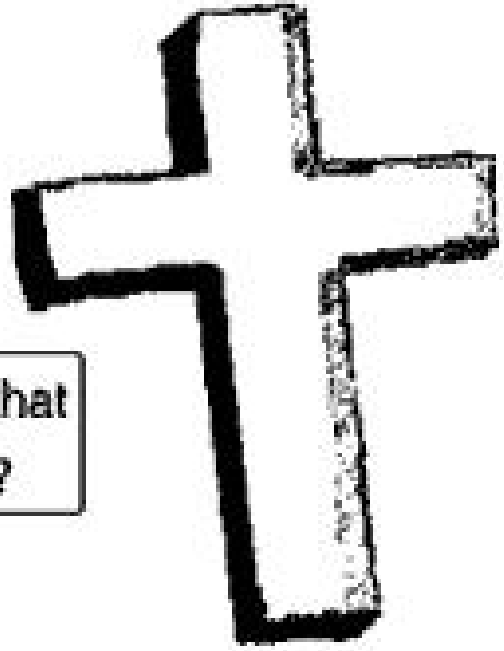

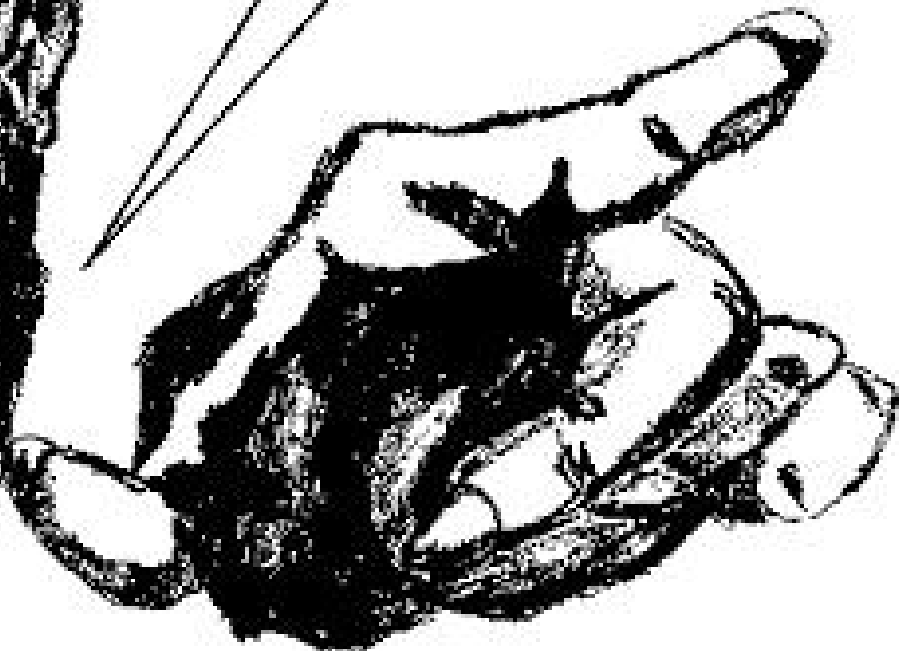

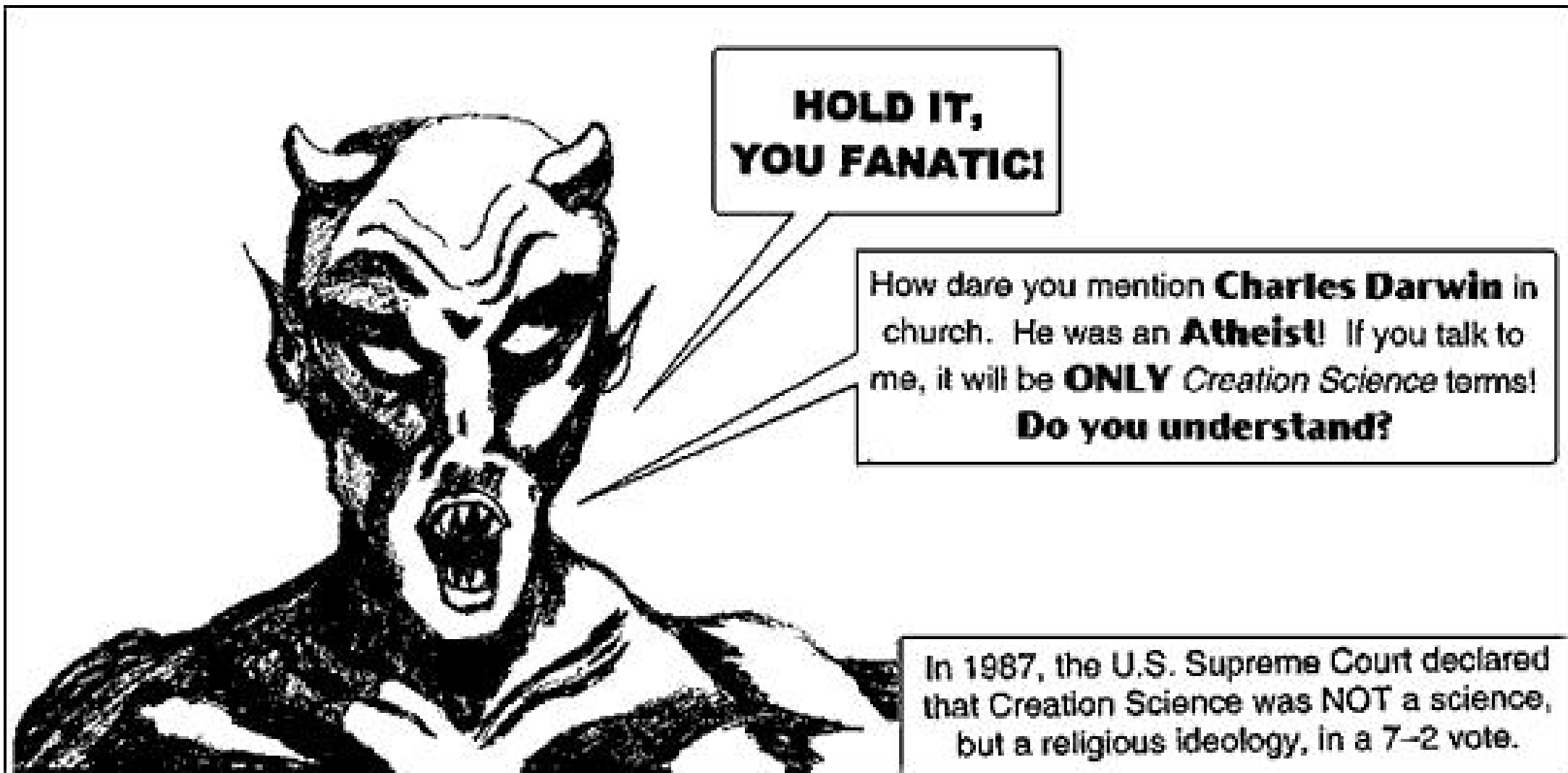

Pieced together by fragmentary Bible verses, we can confidently state that the earth and universe are 6,000 years old. And radiocarbon dating supports it.



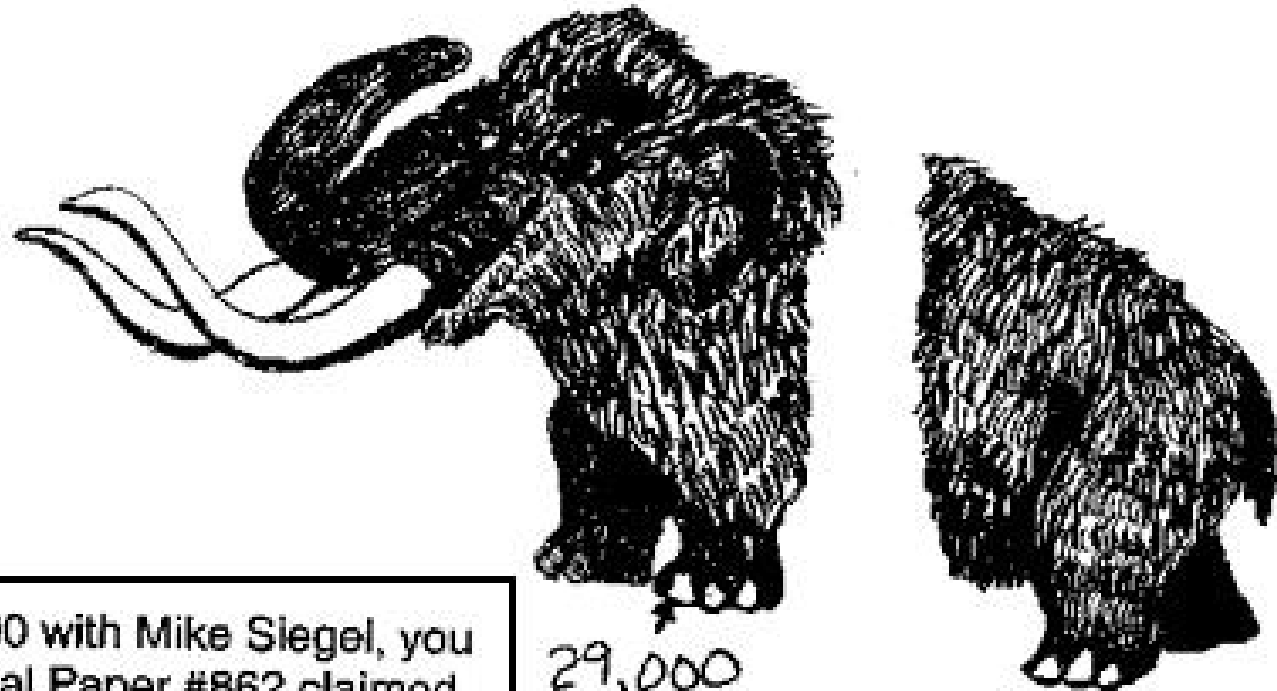
Sir, I have in my possession a USGS Paper that contradicts your claim about radiocarbon dates from a woolly mammoth. May I show it?

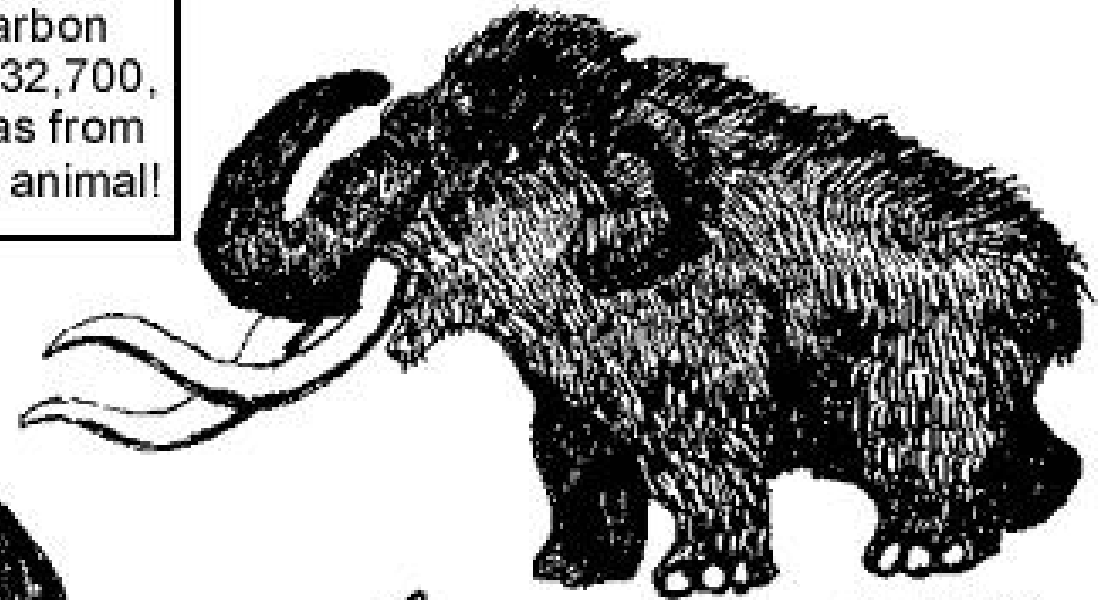
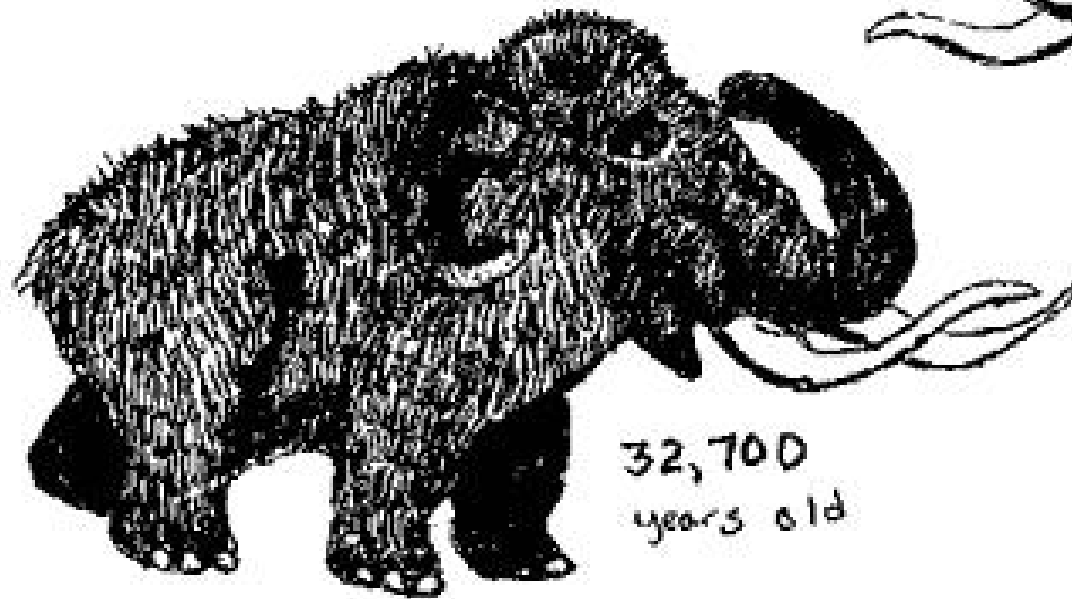

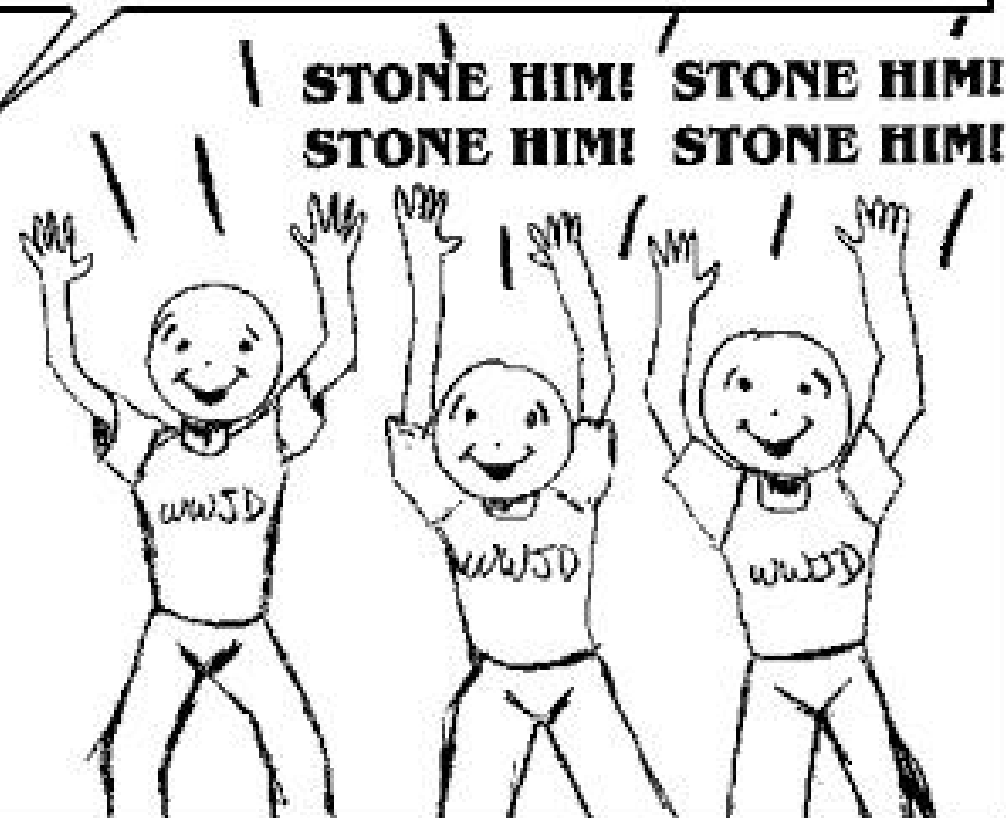


Well . . .

gives us permission to *stone you to death!*



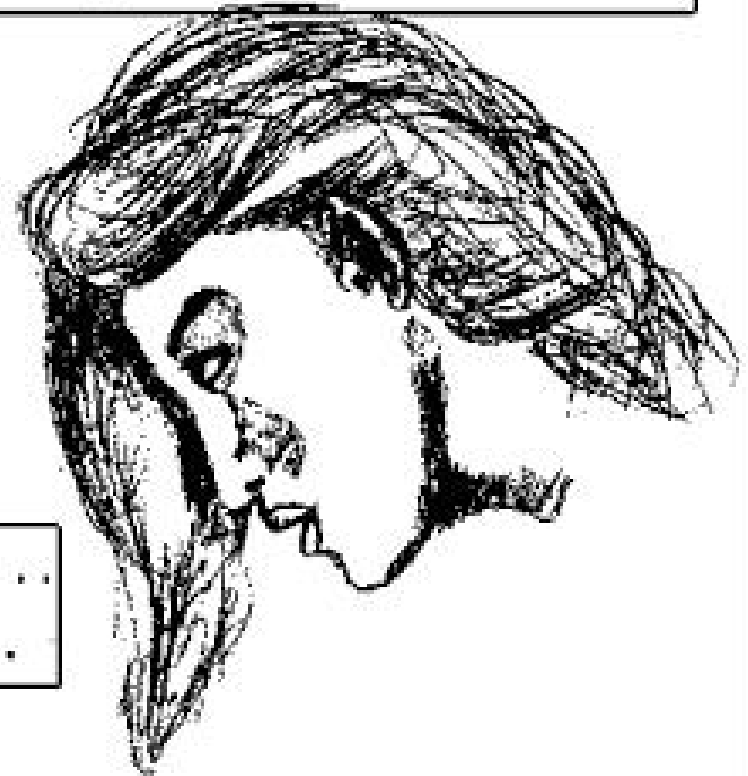
(Gulp) She's destroying me!

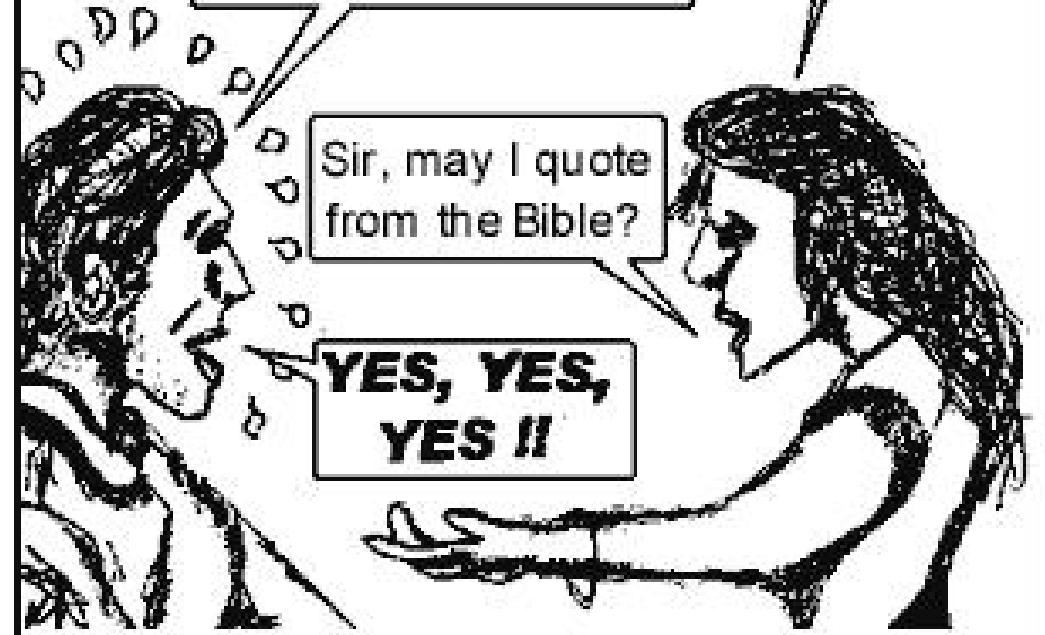
I, uh ... (gulp) ... huh?

Are you saying that I'm misrepresenting empirical science and the Holy Bible?




Yes!

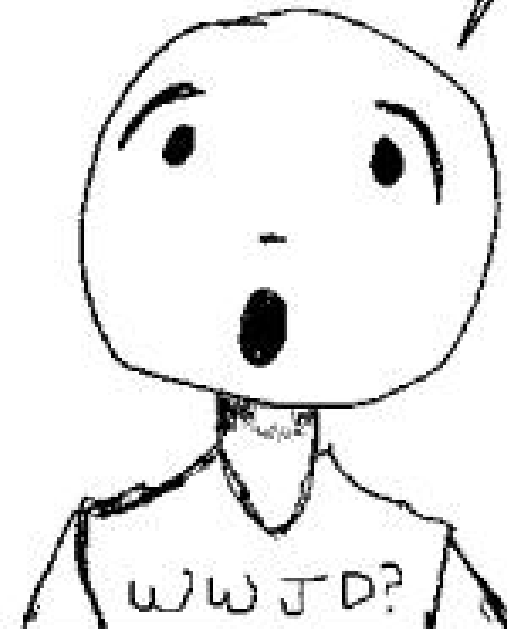
Dr. Dino has been *lying* to us about what's in the Bible and our science books?
